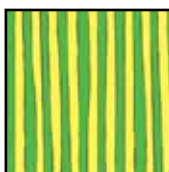

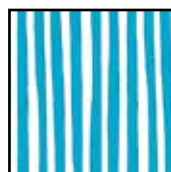

Cutting Directions:

WOF= width of fabric

Pre-wash and size or starch all fabric before cutting

Panel 21872Q Fussy cut the main vignette panel to 18½" x 24½". Fussy cut 4 - 6" x 6" square vignettes for corner stone blocks selecting a variety.

Green Print 21873G Cut 5 strips @ 1 7/8" x WOF
Border #3 blocks

Orange Print 21873O Cut 5 strips @ 1½" x WOF; Sub cut 2 strips @ 1 ½" x 41", join the remaining 3 strips together using diagonal seams and cut 2 strips @ 1 ½" x 50" Border #4.

Yellow Crescent moon 21874S Cut 4 strips @ 3 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 24 rectangles @ 3 ¼" x 6" Border #3 blocks.

Bright Blue Full Moon 21875Q Cut 4 strips @ 1¾" x WOF; sub cut 2 strips @ 1 ¾" x 41", sub cut 2 strips @ 1 ¾" x 31" Border #2

Yellow Full Moon 21875S Cut 4 strips @ 1 3/8" x WOF; sub cut 2 strips @ 1 3/8" x 41", sub cut 2 strips @ 1 5/8" x 31"
Center all four strips on the moon motif; Border #1

Orange Stars 21876O Cut 2 strips @ 4" x WOF
Cut 1 strip @ 3" x WOF

Blue Stars 21876Y Cut 5 strips @ 1 7/8" x WOF, Border #3 blocks Cut 2 strips @ 1 ¾" x WOF, sub cut 2 strips @ 24½" x 1 ¾" center panel top & bottom strips.

Orange & Green stripe 21877GO
Cut 1 strip @ 4 ¼" x WOF

Yellow & Green stripe 21877GS
Cut 1 strip @ 4 ¼" x WOF

Blue & White stripe 21877OZ Use your favorite method to make 200" of bias binding.

Sewing Directions:

Use a ¼" seam and sew with right sides together.

Creating the diamond strip:

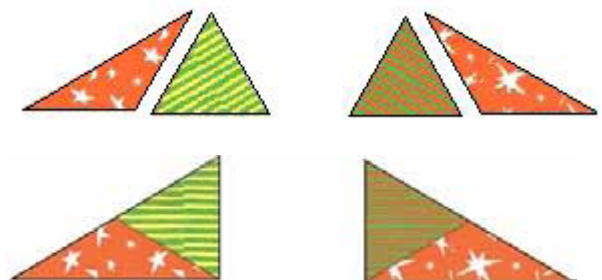
1. Create templates for the diamonds and half diamonds. Cut out all pieces as listed below; make sure the stripe orientation is correct for each piece.

Orange & Green stripe; from the 4 ¼" strip; sub cut 12 triangles using the setting triangle template
Yellow & Green stripe; from the 4 ¼" strip; sub cut 12 triangles using the setting triangle template
Orange Stars; from the 4" strips; sub cut 10 diamonds using the diamond template and from the 3" strip; sub cut 4 triangles using the half diamond template.

1. Sew together a Orange & Green striped setting triangle, a Orange Stars diamond and Yellow & Green striped setting triangle, as shown below. Make sure the stripe orientation is correct for each unit. Press the seams towards the striped triangles. Do not trim the "dog ears" yet, they will be helpful when it's time to join the diagonal units. Make 10 center units.



2. Sew together a Orange & Green striped setting triangle and, a Orange Stars half diamond, as shown below. Make sure the stripe orientation is correct for each unit. Make 2 end units of this combination. Repeat with the Yellow & Green striped setting triangle and, a Orange Stars half diamond. Make sure the stripe orientation is correct for each unit. Press the seams towards the striped triangles. Do not trim the "dog ears" yet, they will be helpful when it's time to join the diagonal units. Make 2 end units of this combination.



3. Lay out 5 center units and one each of the end units as shown below. Sew the units together. All the “dog ears” should line up when you join the units together. Use precision pinning at the seam if you wish to be exact. Repeat to make a second row. Set the diamond strips aside.



Center Section

4. Sew one Blue Stars $24\frac{1}{2}''$ x $1\frac{3}{4}''$ strip to the top of the fussy cut center panel & the other $24\frac{1}{2}''$ x $1\frac{3}{4}''$ strip to the bottom of the fussy cut center panel. Press the seam towards the fussy cut panel.

5. Sew a diamond strip to the top of the panel/Blue Stars assembly and repeat on the bottom of the panel/Blue Stars assembly. Press the seam towards the Blue Stars strip. This assembly should measure $24\frac{1}{2}''$ x $34\frac{1}{2}''$



Adding the mitered borders:

Borders 1 & 2:

1. Sew each Yellow Full Moon $1\frac{3}{8}''$ x $41''$ strip to a Bright Blue Full Moon $1\frac{3}{4}''$ x $41''$ strip. Press the seams towards the Bright Blue Full Moon strip. Sew each Yellow Full Moon $1\frac{5}{8}''$ x $31''$ strip to a Bright Blue Full Moon $1\frac{3}{4}''$ x $31''$ strip. Press the seams away from the Bright Blue Full Moon strip.

2. Using your favorite mitered border technique, attach the $41''$ long border strip sets to the sides of the center panel. Sew the $31''$ long border strip sets to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Make sure that the Yellow Full Moon border is next to the center panel assembly.

This assembly should measure $28''$ x $39''$, trim to the **correct size before adding the border 3.**

Border 3:

3. Sew the Green Print and Blue Stars $1\frac{7}{8}''$ x WOF strips together along the long side of the strip. Press



the seam towards the Green Print, as shown below.

4. Cut 96 rectangles @ $1\frac{7}{8}''$ wide along the seam. Make sure you give the edge a fresh cut that is square to the center seam and re-trim after every 4 pieces to ensure that the pieces are still square to the seam.



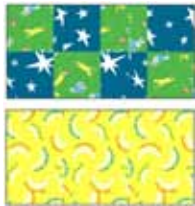
5. Sew pairs of rectangles together into a four patch unit, as shown below.



6. Sew pairs of the four patch units together as shown below to make an eight patch unit. You should have 24 of these eight patch units.



7. Sew the long side of an eight patch unit to the long side of a Yellow Crescent moon $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 6" rectangle. Press the seam towards the Yellow Crescent moon rectangle.



Repeat to make 24 blocks. Finished block size 6"

8. To make the side border strips, sew 7 blocks together as shown below. Make a second strip of 7 blocks and set aside.



9. To make the top and bottom border strips, sew 5 blocks together as shown below. Make a second strip of 5 blocks.



10. Sew the fussy cut bunny images the ends of the top and bottom border strips as shown below. Make sure that one row has the Yellow Crescent moon rectangles on the top of the strip and the other has them on the bottom of the strip. Refer to quilt image.

11. Sew the side border strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams away from the block borders. Make sure that the strip is rotated correctly.

12. Sew the top and bottom border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams away from the block borders. Make sure that the strip is rotated correctly.

13. Sew the Orange Print $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50" strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the Red Print strips.

14. Sew the Orange Print $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the Red Print strips

Layer, quilt and bind.
